Build a winning hand of 5 cards  and win a fabulous prize!

Walk  sometime between Wednesday, October 12<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup> and earn your Poker cards! It's that easy! 

We will be playing   
**Five Card Draw Poker with Jokers & One-Eyed Jacks Wild!**



**Suggested donation ranging from \$1 to \$5 to play.**  
(However, it's ultimately up to you and whatever you're comfortable with!)



**Here are the House Rules:**

**1. Registration is required.**

There will be a maximum of 5-6 players per Poker deck. Number of decks depends on number of registered players.

To register, send Melissa Smith an email anytime between now and Wednesday, October 12<sup>th</sup>.

**2. Build your poker hand** starting Wednesday, October 12<sup>th</sup> through Wednesday October 26<sup>th</sup>.

5 minutes of walking = 1 Poker card.

Over the two week period, walk 5 times at a minimum of 5 minutes per walk **OR** take a 25 minute walk to earn all 5 Poker cards at once.

**3. Email your walk time(s) and the number of card(s) you have earned to Melissa Smith**, then go to the card dispensing table (across from the mail room) and pick your card(s) from your color deck (deck color will be assigned at registration).

Jokers and One-Eyed Jacks are wild and can be used as any card in the deck to help you improve your hand.

**4. A few quirky house rules:**

Dealer Draw Cards replace less desirable card(s) in your hand.

Maximum of three (1 bonus card given upon registration **AND** 2 additional earned cards).

Walk an extra 5 or 10 minutes and earn extra 1 or 2 cards.

You are not required to use or earn a Dealer Draw Card. Using a Dealer Draw Card is always taking a chance.

The new card could be better, or could be worse. Only you can decide to play those odds. 😊

**5. Seal your final 5 card hand** in an envelope with your name on it and drop it off in the Final Poker Hand box (across from mail room).

Final hands can be dropped off at any time and **must** be placed in the Final Poker Hand box by 5 p.m.

Wednesday, October 26<sup>th</sup>.

Important: *ONLY turn in 5 cards. Hands with more than 5 cards will be disqualified.*

Winning hands will be announced on Thursday, October 27<sup>th</sup>.



**Winners and Prizes.**

Top winning hand from each color deck wins a prize.

Highest winning hand of the color deck winners will receive top prize.

In the event the top hand from two or more color decks tie, there will be a sudden death draw to determine winning order.

Prizes (so far\*) are: 1)Lunch with Dean; 2)Four bonus casual days; 3)Subway gift card.

\*Number of prizes determined by number of people/decks used. Additional prizes will be added if greater participation warrants.



**Here are Examples of Winning Hands (From highest to lowest):**

**K♦ K♥ K♣ K♠ W**


**Five of a Kind (Requires a wild card)**



**Royal Flush** (5 sequential cards of same suit, must be cards 10 thru Ace)




**Straight Flush** (sequential cards of same suit)



Four of a Kind



Full House (Three of a Kind coupled with a Pair)



Flush (5 non-sequential cards of same suit)



Straight (5 sequential cards made up of multiple suits)



Three of a Kind



Two Pair



One Pair



Nothing (The single highest card would beat a lower card of an opponent's nothing hand)
